SUPPORT S.22

- THE LEGISLATION IS BIPARTISAN.
- IT PROTECTS PUBLIC LANDS, RURAL COMMUNITIES, AND LOCAL ECONOMIES.
- IT INCLUDES PROVISIONS TO ENSURE ACCESS FOR RECREATION, INCLUDING HUNTING AND FISHING. THESE PROVISIONS ARE SUPPORTED BY THE NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION.
- MANY OF THE BILLS HAVE GONE THROUGH LENGTHY COLLABORATIVE PROCESSES AND HAVE THE SUPPORT OF LOCAL AND NATIONAL STAKEHOLDERS AND ELECTED OFFICIALS.
- THE LEGISLATION IS REVENUE NEUTRAL.
